ARBC DERBY SHOW
2017 Show Information & Conditions

1. Entries must be RECEIVED no later than **Wednesday 27th March 2017**. ALL LATE ENTRIES WILL INCUR A PENALTY FEE OF \$30 PER EVENT - THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED – THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. **Late entries will only be accepted by 3pm the previous day of the class.**
3. A vet certificate must be provided prior to commencement of show (Wednesday 7.00 am) before any requests for refunds will be considered.
4. Owners and riders must be current financial members of the National Reining Horse Association and Reining Australia. All horses must be licensed with the NRHA. Any transfers of ownership need to be completed by the NRHA prior to showing. A copy of horse competition license and NRHA membership card must accompany entry form: otherwise entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
5. The working order will be drawn and posted; all late entries will run first.
6. All sanctioned classes will be run in accordance with NRHA rules with the exception of the Freestyle – see condition 12.
7. 50% of the entry fee will be retained and apply to jackpot classes.
8. All exhibitors will be subject to the use of photographers & videographers under the direction of show Management for the benefit of show promotions.
9. The Maturity is open to four year old horses only to be ridden one handed in a bridle.
10. The Derbies are open to four, five and six year old horses to be ridden one handed in a bridle.
- 10a. To enter the ARBC Derbies all horses must be by nominated Stallions or have paid the appropriate fee to enter the Intermediate and Limited Division within the Open Derby, riders must first be nominated in the Open Derby.
- 10b. To enter the Intermediate and Limited Division within the Non Pro Open Derby, riders must first be nominated in the Non Pro Derby.
11. Horses that are entered for both events in concurrent run class will only have one run and the score will count for both events and will therefore **only pay one Judges Fee and Video fee upon nomination**.
12. Payouts will be in accordance with the NRHA Payback Scale with the exception of the feature event (ARBC Open Derby) which will pay as follows:
1st = 28% 2nd = 18% 3rd = 16% 4th = 14% 5th = 8% 6th = 6% 7th = 4% 8th to 10th = 2% each

STALLION OWNER INCENTIVE: The Stallion Owner Incentive is a benefit of the program that pays money back to the Stallion Owner in the ARBC program. 5% of all prize money is paid back to the owner of the Stallion; this payment applies to all levels Non Pro and Open Prize money only.

13. Freestyle Rules – Use NRHA rulebook as guideline. Competitors must supply own music (CD Or Stick) which must be in the hands of the announcer by Thursday 13th April AM.
14. For Non sanctioned events on Wednesday including Green Rider, Riders may use one or two hands on the Reins or change from one handed to two handed throughout the performance. Western attire and any legal headgear allowed, must be member of RA, NRHA or any RA Affiliates.
15. Beginner Rider - Restricted to riders who have not won more than three (3) non-sanctioned Reining events or one (1) sanctioned Reining event as at 1st January 2017.
16. All stables must be left clean. A \$25 Cleaning Bond must be paid with nominations.
17. By way of making an entry you are assuming responsibility for and binding owner, rider and/or agent to the terms and conditions as set out. The indemnity and consent form accompanying entry form must be completed and signed or entries will not be accepted.
18. Management reserves the right to alter this program once final entry numbers are known.
19. **The Grounds will available to Bump in Sunday 9th April.**

20. DOGS must be kept at campsites. **No dogs allowed in grandstand, Marshaling area or in vicinity of Canteen.** All dog droppings must be picked up, especially in the stable area.
21. No smoking in the main arena grandstand. Please use designated smoking areas.
22. All competitors riding on the grounds must have saddles and bridle and correct footwear at all times. All youth riders must wear a helmet at all times when riding.
23. All Children must have correct footwear in the Marshaling area.
24. No bikes or scooters to be ridden in or around the stables or marshaling area.
25. Only competitors and Strappers will be allowed in marshaling area.

Event participants are required to make their own on-line booking and payment for nominations, stables, Camp sites and Paid Warm Up least one week prior to the event. The required fees will be collected through this process by Nominate Pty Ltd and forwarded direct to ARBC.

Preference for warm up slots will be given to sponsors.
